### Job Responsibilities

The Vice President of Advancement is a remote position and reports to the Chief Operating Officer. It is responsible for the following:

- Lead the mid-major and major gifts team as they manage their portfolios.
- Develop and manage the Advancement Plan for the ministry's mid-major and major fundraising program. Chair quarterly executive advancement meetings
- Facilitate senior executive connections with major patrons.
- Oversee creation of donor-related materials including print and electronic appeals, stewardship communication, and meeting material.
